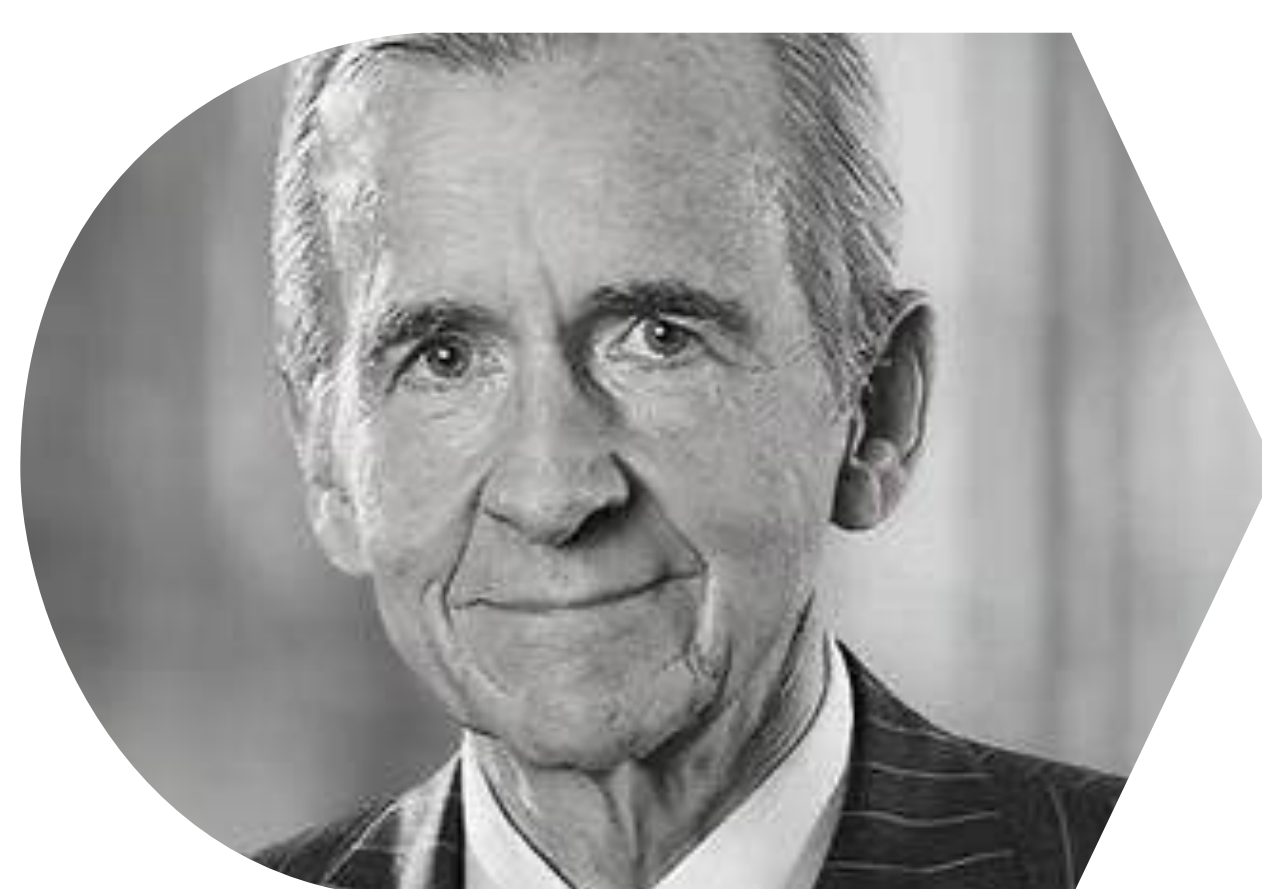


Patrick Richard

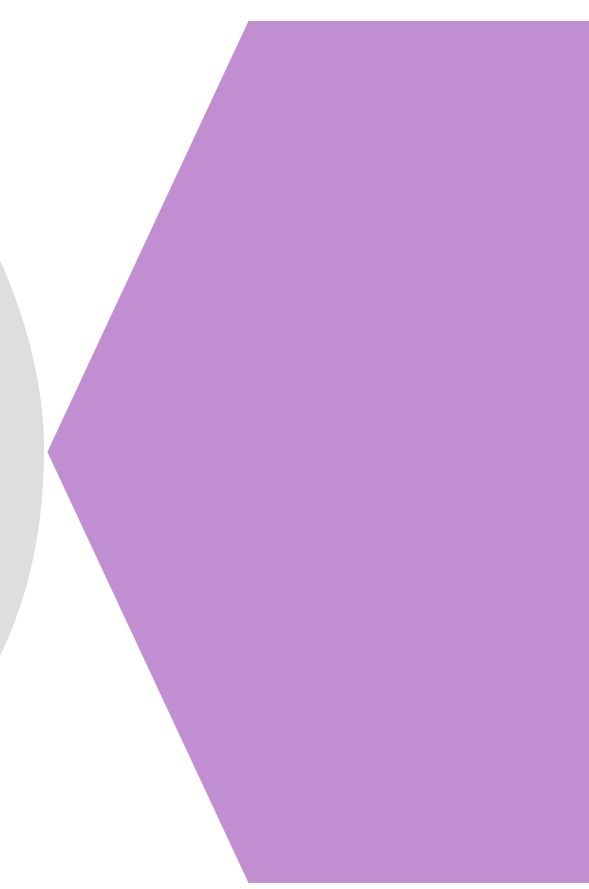
